Unique & United

Students Rebuild invites young people around the world to create art that sparks change. This year's Unique & United campaign celebrates what makes each of us different while highlighting the common threads that connect us all.

Double the Kindness

During our Double the Kindness period, from February 13th-27th, in honor of Valentine's Day and Random Acts of Kindness Week, every creative expression or youth engaged unlocks \$10 toward our goal, doubling the impact students can make. The activities below connect the themes of kindness, individuality, and unity through creative expression.

Kindness Ideas

"Best Part of You" Portrait Wall

Students create a portrait of a classmate and write one sentence about how that person shows kindness in their own unique way. Display together on a shared wall.

Supplies: Paper, markers/crayons/colored pencils, tape or staples for display

Spoken Word: "My Kind Voice"

Students write and perform a short poem (3-5 lines) about their own unique way of being kind.

Supplies: Paper, pencils, optional: microphone or recording device

Two Voice Kindness Poems

Pairs of students each write lines about what kindness means to them, then read them aloud together, alternating lines and ending on a shared line that unites their perspectives.

Supplies: Paper, pencils

"Kindness Is Universal" Collaborative Banner

Students each illustrate or write about kindness in their own style, language, or cultural context. Assemble individual pieces into a single banner that showcases diverse expressions of the same value.

Supplies: Paper squares or strips, markers/crayons/paint, large banner paper or bulletin board, glue or tape

"Unique & United I Show Kindness By..."

Students complete the phrase "I show kindness by..." through an illustrated poster or a short video clip, highlighting how their unique personality, background, or strengths shape the way they show kindness. Display as a gallery or compile into a class video.

Supplies: Paper, markers/crayons for posters; phones or tablets for video option

Valentine's Day Ideas

“You Are One of a Kind” Valentine’s

Students create handmade valentines for classmates that go beyond generic messages, highlighting something unique about that person and how they show kindness.

Supplies: Paper or cardstock, markers/crayons/colored pencils, stickers or decorations (optional)

Heart Map

Students create a heart-shaped artwork filled with the people, places, and things they care about, showing their unique identity and what connects them to others.

Supplies: Paper, markers/crayons/colored pencils

“What Makes Us Beat as One”

Each student decorates a small heart with something unique about themselves. Assemble all hearts into one large heart shape, showing unity.

Supplies: Small paper hearts, markers/crayons, large poster board or wall space, tape or glue
